A RESOLUTION BY THE POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE VICTORIA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION ADOPTING THE FY 2022 ANNUAL PROJECT LISTING

WHEREAS, the Victoria Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Advisory Committee is the transportation planning decision-making body for the Victoria metropolitan planning area; and

WHEREAS, The Victoria MPO is responsible for cooperatively developing a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated the preceding program year; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Project Listing (APL) was made available in accordance with the Victoria MPO's Public Participation Plan (PPP); and

WHEREAS, the Victoria MPO recommends the adoption of the FY 2022 APL via resolution for submittal to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VICTORIA MPO POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

Section 1. That the MPO Administrator of the Victoria MPO is hereby authorized to submit the FY 2022 APL to TxDOT, FHWA, and FTA on behalf of the Policy Advisory Committee; and,

Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

23 CFR § 450.334 requires that the “Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year.” Furthermore, 23 CFR §450.334(b) states that the Annual Project Listing (APL) must “be consistent with the funding categories identified in the MPO’s Transportation Improvement Program.” Obligated projects in this report are categorized into four project types: highways, other grouped projects, transit, and bicycle and pedestrian.

This report provides an overview of the transportation planning and programming process and the resulting federal funding obligation of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Victoria MPO’s 2022 fiscal year (October 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022). Obligation is the Federal government’s commitment to pay its fair share of the project cost. Obligation happens at the time when the project is executed, and the State of Grantee requests the funds. For Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. In summary, an obligated project is one that has been approved by the Federal government for reimbursement. Projects contained in the APL may not have been initiated or completed in the fiscal year.

METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

The Victoria MPO, acting through the City of Victoria Planning Department and in coordination with the Texas Department of Transportation (Txdot), is responsible for coordinated, comprehensive, and continuing transportation planning for all modes of surface transportation in the Victoria Metropolitan Area. As an urbanized area with a population over 50,000, the Victoria MPO has been designated as an MPO by the Governor since 1982. The Victoria MPO is governed by a 10-member Policy Advisory Committee comprised of elected and non-elected officials from the MPO’s Metropolitan Area. The Victoria Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO) FY 2022 Annual Project Listing (APL) will be available for citizen review/comment beginning Friday, May 5 through Tuesday, June 13, 2023. Copies of the FY 2022 APL will be available at the City of Victoria's Development Services office, located at 700 Main Center, Suite 129 and placed on the City's website at www.victoriatx.gov/738/Victoria-MPO. The FY 2022 APL is a report produced each year that provides a list of all transportation projects that received federal obligation in FY 2022 (October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022). Obligated projects are those that have been approved by the federal government for reimbursement.

An initial public hearing will be held on the Draft FY 2022 APL, as is required per 23 CFR § 450.334(c), on Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. in the Public Works Facility Training Room, 1301 SW Ben Jordan St, Victoria, Texas. 


