



Fall Adult Softball & Kickball League FAQ's

Fall League Registration: Aug 31st-Oct 2nd and is \$300/team

Fall League Late Registration: Oct 3rd – Oct 7th and is \$325/team

Fall Leagues will begin the Week of October 19th (Pending Summer Season)

Equipment: Kickballs will be provided for all games. Softball players must bring their own balls for use. Men's leagues are only allowed to use the **12" USSSA Classic Plus balls** and Coed leagues can only use the 12" USSSA Classic Plus balls (men) and **11" USSSA Classic W balls** (women). **USSSA slow-pitch stamped bats** will be the only legal bat for use (fastpitch bats and "senior" bats are illegal).

Starting this Fall League, ID's must be presented to sign and/or confirm a roster spot. Players must be at least 18 years old to participate in the leagues. No exceptions or waivers. Teams can turn in a prior signed roster, but the player(s) will not be officially on the roster until they present an ID to confirm. A roster is due prior to their first scheduled game. There is a maximum of 20 people per roster and players cannot be removed from the roster once it is submitted. For coed, there must be 5 women on the field/lineup at all times. Roster will become locked as of 5pm on Friday, November 13th.

***Open League ***

An open league means that there is no gender requirement to play as compared to Coed or Men's league. Upper & Lower players can play in this league. They will still need to turn in a roster to be eligible to play.
